Dear Residents,

Re.: Solid Waste Management

"Reduce, Reuse, Recycle" are known as 3 Rs of waste hierarchy. Waste Management means, collecting, transporting, processing, recycling and monitoring of the waste material. The term waste management generally relates to those materials which are produced by human activity and as usual undertaken to reduce the effect of these activities on their health and environment.

Now coming to the point as widely being publicized in newspaper and directions passed by the Hon'ble NGT from time to time, all the resident welfare associations having more than 5000 sq. meter gated area shall ensure segregation of waste at source by the generators in and handover recyclables to authorised waste pickers. The wet waste/biogradable waste shall be processed, treated and disposed off through composting within the society premises. The three steps solution of solid waste management is segregate, composting, reuse.

- 1. Organic Waste:-
- a) <u>Kitchen Waste</u>:- Vegetables, Food peels, Egg shells, chicken bones and fish bones.
- b) Garden Waste:- Fallen leaves, twigs, weeds, pooja flowers, trimmings
- 2. <u>Dry Waste</u>:-

- a) Plastic:- Bottles, covers, cups, milk pouches (must be washed & dried)
- b) <u>Papers</u>:- Newspaper, Pizza Boxes, Tetra packs, Cartons, Paper Cups, Stationery.
- c) <u>Miscellaneous</u>:- Metal container, Glasses, Bottles (Unbroken), Thermocol, Coconut shells and old mops.

3. Reject Waste:-

Sanitary pads, napkins, diapers (wrap in newspaper and marked with red ink for identification), tissues, bandages, condoms, razor blades, syringes and broken glasses.

Having explained above you all concept and plan of waste management we expect 100% cooperation and understanding in days to come for seamless and successful implementation of the same. The segregation of waste will be at source of the generator in stream and handover recylabeles to authorize pickers. The wet waste shall be processed, treated and disposed through composting within the society premises. For this purpose 3x3 feet pit has been constructed near sports park. Anyone not complying with the directions of NGT/MCD will be liable to pay environmental compensation @ Rs.10000/- for default. Therefore all the residents are requested to please handover/dry/plastic material duly segregated to the picker of the waste. If any resident fails to comply with the segregation clause the picker will have the authority to refuse the material of the resident. As such all are requested to please cooperate and handover only segregated waste to the picker.

However to make the picture very clear we have arranged Seminar on Sunday in Society Office at 11.00 a.m. about the whole process and its implementation at 11.00 a.m. All are requested to attend the Seminar to have more clarity on the subject and its implementation.
